Hickory High Principal Accepts Position in Allegheny County

Dr. Kim Mattox has accepted the position of Assistant Superintendent in Allegheny County.

Dr. Mattox began her career with Hickory Public Schools as assistant principal at Hickory High School in 2003. She was named principal on July 1, 2004 and has served as principal of Hickory High School for seven years.
